<p>Minutes of Previous Meeting The minutes of the meeting held on Monday 14th January 2019 were approved as a true record. (proposed Cllr D.Hurford, seconded Cllr T.Waite)</p>	
<p>Crime Report and Neighbourhood Watch Details of the anti-social behaviour car signs have been sent by PCSO Mike Jordan, but not details of who supplies & manufactures. Councillors agreed to purchase 3 signs, to be sited 1) opposite the old shop 2) at the turning circle 3) In the car park subject to agreement on price. Councillors also agreed: # to take advice from A&S Police as to appropriate wording for the signs & to get consent for use of the A&S logo # to request contact details the manufacturers & obtain a price to include fixing..</p>	clerk
<p>Public Forum Cllr Balli updated the council with regard to the programme of road closures currently being undertaken. NSC did not seem to appreciate how 2 simultaneous road closures caused rat runs & traffic jams in Dundry village. It was also reported that the noticeboard in east Dundry has fallen over, it appears after the 'legs' has snapped with rot. The chair & clerk will assess what repairs are needed & whether this is economic. There was also a discussion about whether that noticeboard is well used, & whether replacement is economic.</p>	Chair/ clerk
