Dundry Playground Group’s journey

March 2010	Applied to Community Spaces (Stage 1) for £30K for a playground in Dundry, in response to Parish Plan. £2.5K already available from Quartet
May 2010	Applied for development fund to pay for planning application and design
June 2010 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leah de Boer won the logo competition • Development grant approved (£1K) • Dundry Day – consultation and fundraising • Met NS playrangers about play sculpture
July 2010	Location consultation. Published consultation documents on website
September 2010	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community Feedback Event • Dundry Playground Group’s first AGM, adopted constitution

Dundry Playground Group’s journey continued....

October 2010	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Submitted planning application with design by Touch Wood
November 2010	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tendering started for playground work Play sculpture community workshop Planted 28 trees (Woodland Trust)
December 2010	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Completed tender evaluation – Children’s Playground Company won Submitted Stage 2 application form and 100+ pages of supporting information to Community Spaces – asked for £50K
January 2011	Play sculpture open for play
April 2011	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stage 2 application approved Agreement with Children’s Playground Company signed
June 2011	Work on first part of playground – mound and tunnel - completed
August 2011	Applied for sustainability grant (£3.5K)
October 2011	Work on playground completed

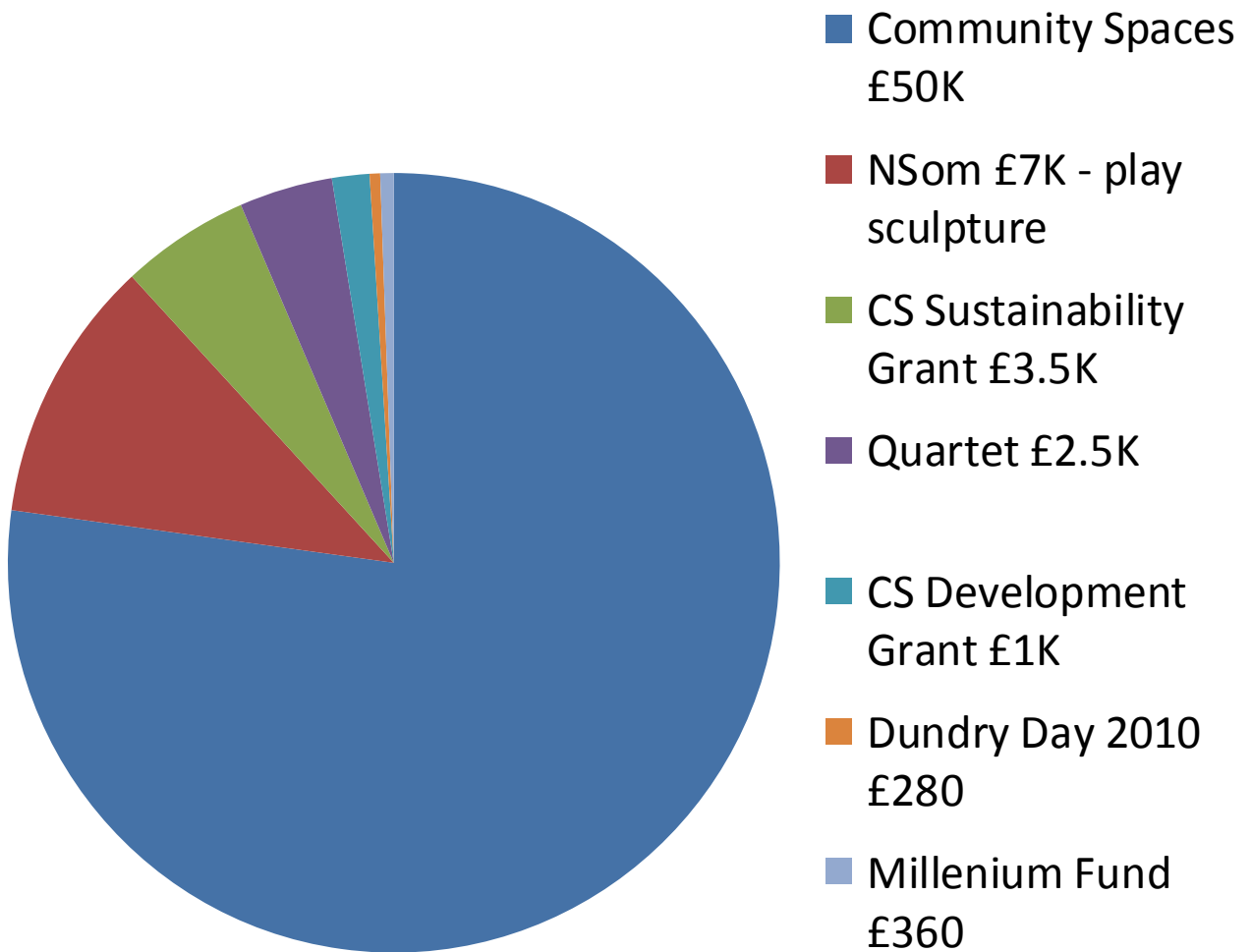

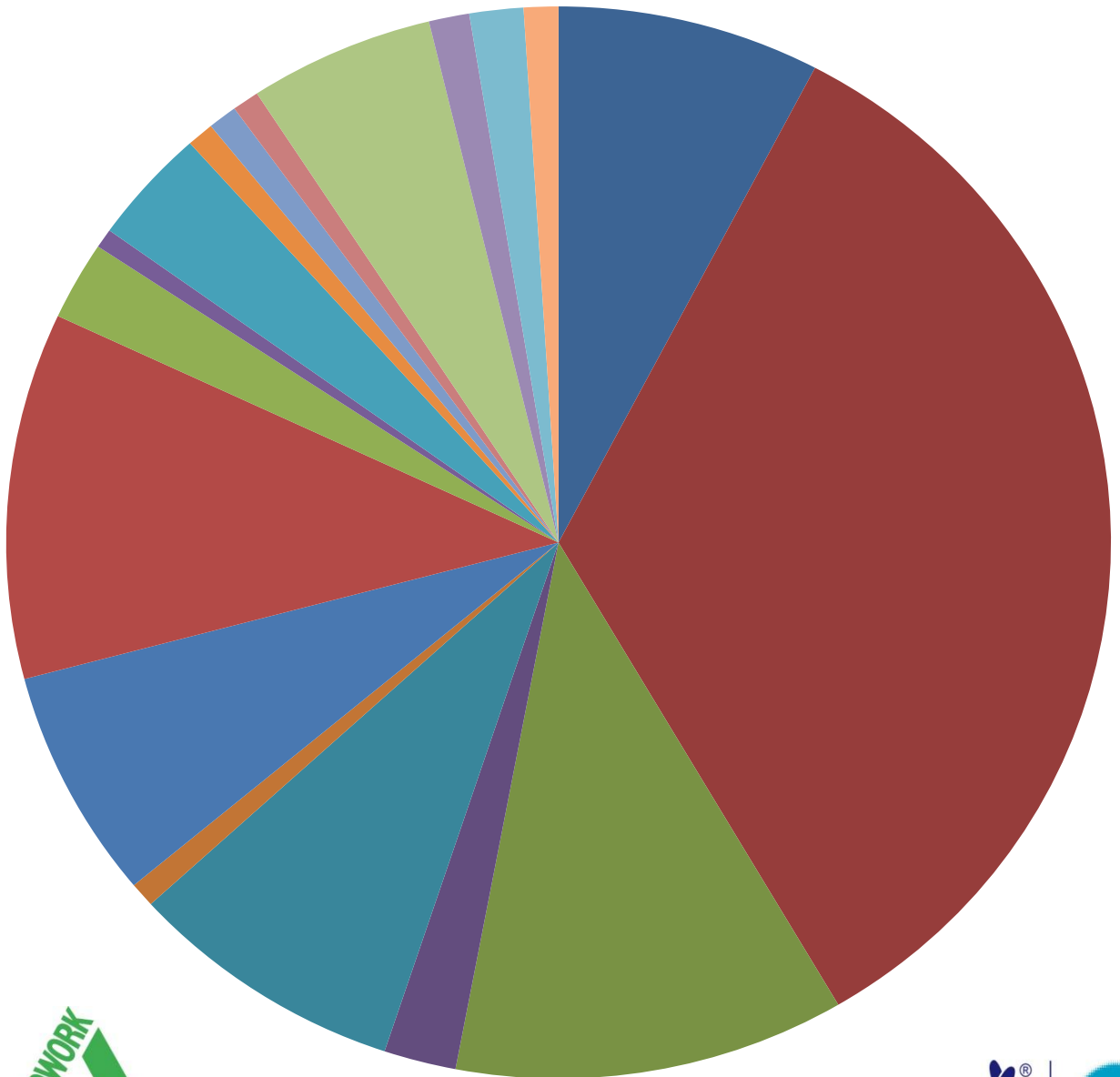

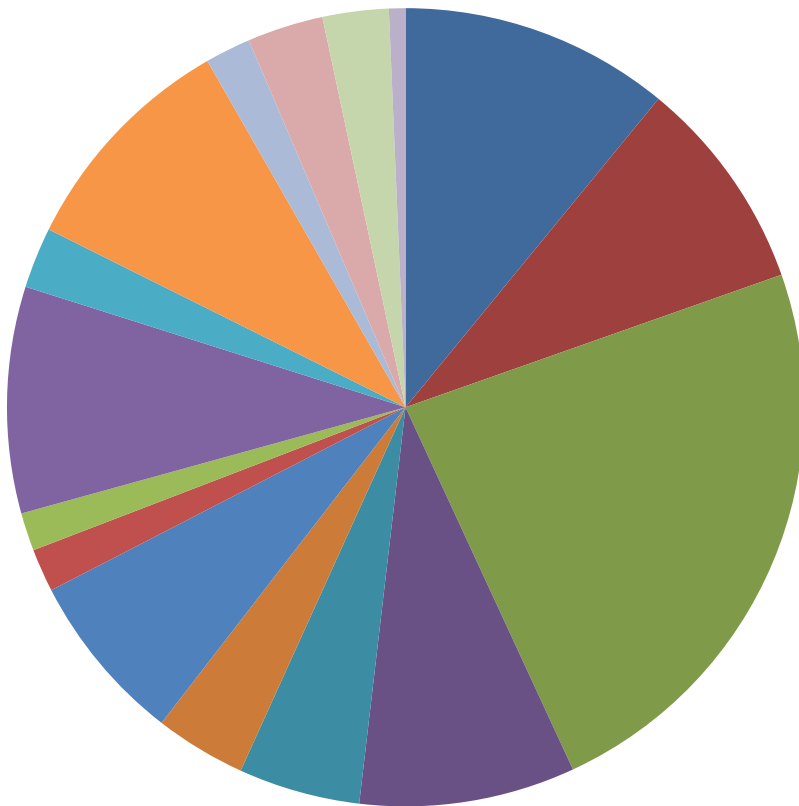
