For Your Information

Specifically relating to the month of March 2017:

There has been an increase in the number of reports of Fly Tipping in and around the Dundry area. Whilst North Somerset Council are lead authority with regards to Fly tipping, We, the Police, will always assist where we can.

Annual Report

Dundry is a village within the Redwood Beat Area of North Somerset.

The Beat Area of Redwood covers Nine villages in total.

As can be seen from the breakdown of the figures above, overall there were 974 incidents reported/recorded against the Redwood Beat. Of those reported incidents, 59 relate to Dundry In real terms that equates to 6% of all incidents on Redwood can be attributed to Dundry.

From those issues reported the majority related to 'Other' Issues which include Domestic Arguments, Harassment etc. Criminal Damage and Theft from Motor vehicles coming closely behind.

We are also aware of issues with Nuisance Motorcycles, speeding motorists and Parking being issues affecting the community of Dundry together with Poaching.

In response to the above, you Beat team implemented the following:

We have increased the patrols in and around the Dundry area especially on weekends and evenings and are monitoring the parking issue when we can.

Please can I remind residents that parking issues now come under North Somerset council although, we, the police, will still attend if necessary to assess spontaneous issues.

You will probably be aware that Nailsea Police Station is due to close imminently. The Response Team (i.e. Those whose primary role is to attend emergency calls) are now based at a new building situated near to Junction 21 of M5. Officers are still designated to patrol the North of the district on a daily basis. The Beat Team will shortly be relocated to the Fire Station off of Pound Lane, Nailsea. Therefore we are still local and accessible to our neighbourhoods and their residents and able to quickly address any Neighbourhood issues/Anti Social Behaviour etc that may arise.

Your Beat Team consists of one Beat Manager and two PCSO staff who are responsible for the area of Redwood Beat. We work varying shifts consisting of early tours (0700-1600 hrs and 14.30 - 2300 hrs shifts are extended on Fridays and Saturdays).



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The Nailsea Safer Stronger Neighbourhood Team (of which Redwood is a part) consists in total of Four Beat Managers and 8 PCSO's therefore if I or my PCSO colleagues are not on duty there should be sufficient staff on to address any immediate Neighbourhood concerns.

As for the year ahead, we will continue to serve the community and work in partnership with other stakeholders and agencies to address Neighbourhood issues.

The Nuisance Motorcycles issue is a very historic matter involving off road type motorcycles accessing the woods from South Bristol. We are working in partnership with our Bristol Colleagues and Bristol City Council to address this.

The areas I intend concentrating on personally are listed below (these are, of course subject to change depending on spontaneous issues that may occur):

- 1) Burglary initiative to address and educate residents in Home security
- 2) Parking Initiative across Redwood Beat addressing Pavement Parking working in partnership with North Somerset council and RNIB
- 3) No Cold Calling Zones within Elderly residential areas
- 4) Anti Poaching initiative
