Crime Updates

North Road Parking – There have been several issues involving parking on North Road in Leigh Woods, many of which are vehicles blocking driveways of the residents. This can ultimately lead to the vehicle being ticketed as it is preventing the resident from accessing the highway.

It is also apparent that emergency vehicles such as Fire Engines would struggle to access North Road due to the manner in which people are parking either side.

Flax Bourton Road – Similar issues of motorists parking vehicles on the pavements to the extent that pedestrians are being forced into the road to get round.

Domestic Violence – During COVID we have seen an increase in the Domestic Violence cases being reported to us. This is something we are working tirelessly to combat and reduce. If you have any concerns about friends, family or neighbours then please contact the Police on 999 or 101 in a non-emergency.

ASB Westward Gardens – There has been some ongoing Anti-Social Behaviour in the Westward Gardens area of Long Ashton with neighbour issues spilling into the street. This is ongoing and is on our radar to work alongside alliance in remedying this issue.
