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Dear residents,

Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 Public Space Protection Orders – Dundry Turning Circle

We are writing advise you that following the public consultation in June 2023, a new Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) covering Hill Road, Dundry is now in force.

This PSPO makes it an offence for anyone (including vehicles and pedestrians) to use the public right of way outlined on the map on the back of this letter.

This does not include any person who lives or is visiting premises adjoining the Highway, emergency services or other authorities.

PSPO Enforcement

This order can be enforced by council officers, Police and other organisations designed by the council such as Local Authority Support.

Breach of this PSPO, without a reasonable excuse, is a criminal offence. This may lead to a £75 fixed penalty or prosecution which can lead to a maximum fine of £1,000 and costs.

Patrols will be carried out in the area to enforce this PSPO.

How do I report someone breaching a PSPO?
