<u>Crime Report and Neighbourhood Watch</u> An abandoned car had been reported to the Police, unfortunately still no response.	
<u>Public Forum</u> # a local resident had been in touch about speeding on the Wells Road near maidenhead, with suggestions of speed cameras and possible speed humps. It was agreed to support those concerns to N Somerset Council, there is a long history of speeding on that road with fatalities in the past # a number of local residents have responded to the consultation over the Woodspring housing development and have copied the Parish Council into that correspondence. <u>Councillors items</u> # Repairing the lock on the gates to the village is proving problematic, as it is a 'small job' for many companies. # There will be a meeting about the proposed new road passing the centre of the village, with a residents survey alongside. # There was a discussion about the lack of any transport alternatives to the airport, as part of their expansion plans. Clerk to contact Mayor Helen Godwin to highlight concerns. # North Somerset Council have been back in touch about CCTV cameras, to ask if we are still interested in paying for these & NSC to 'run' them, we have said we are still interested. # There was a discussion about the work being done by landscapes, clock to arrange to meet the contractor up on site Also to circulate the contract specification.
